**ARTSMART** – fun projects using a variety of art media including painting, sculpting, collage and drawing. This winter session we will explore drawing and printmaking media

## For Adults or Multi-Generations:

**“DAYS TO DYE FOR”** – *surface design, fiber art studio workshops... paint & dye “arty” cloth*

Usually one Saturday afternoon per month (12:30 – 4:30). First time fee (\$35) includes materials. Repeat visitors (\$15 - includes dye) *plus additional charge for cloth and other materials*. If you are interested in Days to Dye For, give us your contact information so we can let you know the schedule. Activity is for adults, but mature high school students who are motivated to learn about surface design are also welcome. Winter Dye Days: January 23, March 27

### OPEN CLAY STUDIO

Ongoing (not held on holidays or holiday weekends – call ahead to make sure)

Mondays and Wednesdays 7:00-9:00, Saturdays 10:00-12:00

Children and adults, (children under 10 must register with an adult)

First time individual fee: \$20 and/or \$15, repeat visit fee: \$10 (per 2 hr. session). Includes supplies, Special rates for families (immediate family members - living in one household) and ‘Big Brother/Sister’ mentor matches. Prepay passes are also available!

**Parents and Volunteers are welcome at our Creative Connection activities too! Contact us for more information.**

**Scholarships** for any fee based activities may be available for children who need them and who have demonstrated an interest in art activities while participating in Reach programs.

**OPEN CLAY STUDIO** (see additional description under “For Adults”) We have 4 electric wheels, a slab roller, various clay tools, 2 different types of high fire clay bodies, and various glazes. A clay instructor facilitates the sessions and provides individualized instruction, suggestions and encouragement for projects of your choice. 2 lbs of clay is included with the studio fee. Additional clay can be purchased. We welcome beginners to advanced clay artists, children and adults!

**CREATIVE CONNECTIONS** – FREE, after school art activities on **Tuesdays or Wednesdays (4:00 – 6:00)**. Activities vary to give participants experiences in using skills and imagination with painting, sculpture, drawing, collage, printmaking, and fine crafts. Local artists and volunteers facilitate the activities. Activities are geared for grade school aged children, but we welcome adults who like to play with art and enjoy the company of youth! We welcome everyone, but priority is given to children from the surrounding neighborhoods and those who may find it financially difficult to register for fee based art classes. Creative Connections runs October – May. Please call ahead for information on space availability. **Application for enrollment is required before the start of Winter/Spring term (due by Dec 16, 2009) (Winter term special project: “Patterns of Place” will take place through March 10). Winter/Spring term begins January 13 and ends May 26).**

**TEEN OPEN STUDIO** – FREE studio time for ages 13 – 18. **Thursdays 3:00 – 6:00**. This Winter, Teen Studio participants will be part of a special community project: “Patterns of Place”—MSU faculty and students along with Reach Studio staff will be working with teens on creating an exhibition about our community using photography, printmaking, painting, and poetry. Professional artists will work with participants to hone their skills in these art forms, along with encouraging self expression and creativity. Register ahead by calling 999 – 3643. Participant and guardian signatures will be required for registration. **Winter/Spring term will begin January 14 and ends May 20**. Space is limited. Enrollment will be based on demonstrated commitment to participate consistently.
